Four Convictions of a Finder's Mindset

Conviction #1: The lost won't find themselves!

Luke 15:8 (NIV): "Or suppose a woman has ten silver coins and loses one. Doesn't she light a lamp, sweep the house and search carefully until she finds it?"

Conviction #2: The lost don't lose their value just because they're lost!

Conviction #3: Pursuing the lost will involve a cost!

Conviction #4: The greatest celebrations this side of heaven are when the lost get found!

Luke 15:9-10 (NIV): "And when she finds it, she calls her friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost coin.' In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents."
